SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

1. This is a Clubman's Event, held under the general regulations of the MSUK incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., these S.R.'s and any other written instructions the promoting Club may issue. The Trial is a qualifying event for the MSUK Sporting Trials Championship 2022 and the B.T.R.D.A. Gold Star Championship.

2. MSUK Permit number is 128214

3. The Trial is open to members of BTRDA, 750 MC, MTCC, Camel Vale MC, Bristol MC, Ross & District MC, NPTCC, and registered contenders for the British Championship.

All competitors must be in possession of a MSUK RS Clubman's Competition License appropriate for this type of event.

A club membership card & License are required for both Driver & Passenger. These must be produced at signing on.

4. The Trial will be held at Eaton, map reference SK 790292. The site is a short distance west of the village on the unclassified road leading to Stathern and Eastwell. The entrance to the site retains the improvements made previously to reduce the problems some of you have encountered in the past. **DO NOT USE THE ROAD THROUGH THE VILLAGE OF EATON** which is very narrow and twisty. This is most important to maintain good relations in the locality and to ensure the continued availability of this site.

5. Starting time 10.30 am. Competitors must sign on 15 minutes before the start time.

The Trial will consist of a minimum of three rounds of at least six sections.

Scrutineering will start at 8.30am.

Signing on will commence at 08:30am

6. There will be the following classes: Red Indy, Red Live, Blue Indy, Blue Live & Rookie. Competitors will be classified according to the B.T.R.D.A. Formula. A competitor may only be in one class.

7. Cars must comply with MSUK National Trials Car Formula and be passed by the scrutineer. Please ensure your Diff seal is intact & visible.

Tyre pressures will be advised by the Clerk of the Course. Tyre pressures will be checked at scrutineering and spot checks may be made during the day. A Brake and Diff Test will be made before cars compete in this trial.

8. Entries will not exceed 45 and the minimum entry will be 20.

Double drives will be permitted if the Secretary is notified before the closing date, and the number of entries does not exceed 25.

9. Closing date for entries is Wednesday 16th November. Entries should be made on the official entry form and sent to the Secretary of the meeting by email or post

ENTRY FEE is **£50.00** per competitor.
