## **Supplementary Regulations**

- 1. The Kentish Border Car Club will organise a Clubmans permit Sporting Trial at Tulleys Farm, Turners Hill, RH10 4PD on Sunday 2nd November 2025
- 2. The Meeting will be governed by the General regulations of Motorsport uk (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these SR's and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. Motorsport uk Permit number: 204974
- 4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and members of the following invited clubs: B.T.R.D.A, NPTCC, 750 MC, MTCC, L&NCMC, Camel Vale MC, Bristol MC, holding an RS Clubman Motorsport uk Competition Licence or higher. Club membership cards and competition licences will be inspected at signing on.
- 5. The event is a round of the 2025 Motorsport uk Sporting Trial Championship, the 2025 B.T.R.D.A. Sporting Trial Championship, sponsored by Tulleys Farm.
- 6. The event will be at Tulleys Farm, Turners Hill. Public Roads will not be used to link sections. There will be 6 to 8 tests on private land to be attempted 3 or 4 times. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills to enable the programme to be completed.
- 7. Scutineering starts at 9-00 am. First test at 10-30 am.
- 8. Awards to be presented as follows:

Best overall performance of the day: Driver and Passenger.

Best Performance Red Class. Independent and Live

Best Performance Blue Class Independent and Live

Best Performance Rookie Class

Best Performance Post Historic Class

- 16. All other GR's of the Motorsportsuk apply as written.
- 17. No person will drive a competing car on the site except the authorised competitor.
- 18. All competing cars must be fitted with an effective silencer. A noise test may be carried out
- 19. The use of motorcycles or quad bikes on the site is restricted to authorised persons only.
- 20. A first aider will be in attendance
- 21. Toilet facilities will be available

  - 24. Permitted tyres for this event: Maxxis MA510, Yokohama GT Classisc 350, Vredestine T Trac 2, Nangkang CX668. Any cars in the Post Historic can use tyres which have been previously listed in tyre list 3

## 25. Differentials

To be classified in the results the car must have a differential fitted that has a break out level of under 15kg fitted with a red seal with numbers matching the master sheet as required by the BTRDA and Motorsports UK championships – cars with Blue "temporary" seals are eligible to participate. Cars with differentials outside this are able to compete but will not be eligible to placed in overall results.
